

Acquisition of museum collection is a regular feature of Vaacha museum. Various workshops are organized for revival of traditional crafts and their documentation. This leads to regular acquisition of artifacts from tribal communities. Also, some of the articles made of terracotta and wood displaced in open spaces require replacement due to withering. This helps in regular commissioning of the tribal artisans. The Museum also has its shop for which craft objects are acquired regularly.

Adivasi Academy has residential primary school Vasantshala of children from migrant tribal families. Vaacha museum is open to these children 24 hours with freedom to take out any musical instrument of their choice to play. This leads to damage sometime. Such articles are either repaired or acquired newly. This established Vaacha as a museum of living culture rather than a museum of antiquity.
